September proved to be much busier as well as being an excellent month weather wise.

The HUMBER was first with a cargo of wheat from Rostock, followed by the Dutch vessel SEA BREEZE with fertilizer, and the molasses tanker ORATANK on the same tide.

The BEN ELLAN, MURIEL and BEN ELLAN again, brought cargoes of wheat and the HANSA LYON a cargo of fertilizer.

The new molasses tanker ALMAR and the DOROTHEA with fertilizer ended the month.
