On the Waterfront by Tommy Legs

October proved to be quite a busy month with eight ships visiting the port. The BEN ELLAN was first with wheat from Liverpool followed by the TAFELBURG with fertilizer from Sfax in North Africa.

They were followed by the ANTARES with wheat from Rostock in Germany and the EMSLAND with woodpulp. The tanker ORATECA then brought molasses from Barry in South Wales and the TRADER fertilizer from St. Petersburg. The WALTER HAMMANN brought fertilizer from Rouen and finally the CELEBRITY brought wheat from Liverpool.

November was an extremely quiet month, only three ships visited the port. There were two small ships, both with wheat, the BOISTEROUS from Bonnières in France and the BEN VARREY from Liverpool followed by the large tanker BRITISH SHIELD with molasses from Barry.
