#### **Something Fishy**

#### Prawns in Garlic Butter

Preparation and cooking time is only 15 minutes, plus thawing if using frozen prawns.

Ingredients:

1 medium onion, peeled and finely chopped 100g (4oz) unsalted butter 3 garlic cloves, peeled and finely chopped 350g (12oz) peeled prawns (thawed if frozen) 2 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley pinch of salt freshly ground black pepper pinch of cayenne 1/4 teaspoon lemon juice 1 lemon, quartered, to garnish

hot crusty wholemeal rolls, to serve

Fry the onion in the butter over moderate heat for four minutes, stirring once or twice. Add the garlic and prawns, stir well and lower the heat. Cook over low heat for five minutes, stirring occasionally.

Stir in half the parsley, and add salt, pepper, cayenne and lemon juice.

Serve the prepared prawns hot, garnished with the remaining parsley and the lemon wedges. Serve with hot crusty rolls and enjoy.

Mrs Elsie Foster provided the lovely spring flowers for the Presidents table. Mrs Rigby was expected


home from Wigton Hospital.
