April proved to be another busy month with ten ships visiting the port. There were three cargoes of fertilizer from the continent by the Irish "Arklow" ships, two by the ARKLOW MOOR and one by the ARKLOW BAY.

There were two cargoes of wheat from Seaforth in Liverpool by the Isle of Man" BEN" boats, the first by the BEN VARREY and the second by the BEN ELLAN. Two molasses tankers the ORATANK and the WEST LYNDA arrived from the continent. The Russian ship LAGODA-12 and the small ship **BOISTEROUS** brought cargoes of wheat and the DORI BRES brought a cargo of fertilizer.
