At a recent meeting of the Town Council, concerns were raised about the safety of pedestrians (particularly children), when emerging from the entrance at West Silloth, to the un-official footpath which crosses over the sports area and links Silloth to West Silloth.

A letter was sent to CAPITA asking that signs be put up warning motorists that there is a concealed entrance but they do not feel this is appropriate.
