This was the culmination of twelve months fund raising and has resulted in a final total of £13,002. This has been divided equally between the two hospitals for equipment requested and specified by the Cardiac Department nursing specialists. Some have been installed already and are used every day.

Fifty teams of four players competed in the golf tournament for the Silloth-on-Solway Charity Trophy, sponsored by Carlsberg, which was won by Edmondson Electrical, Workington.

The runners-up award was won by a talented mixed junior team from Maryport and Silloth.

One highlight of an enjoyable day was when Rebecca Edwards from Maryport, a member of the junior team, made history when she scored a hole-in-one on the 12th hole, this was sponsored by Markley Transport, Silloth, winning her a prize of £200 for her team.

The WACCES committee extends its gratitude to Silloth-on-Solway Golf Club for donating the use of the course and its facilities, and also to everyone who helped or took part for their generosity.

Every prize was donated, and all overheads were covered by sponsors in all the events throughout the year, so that all the money raised has been used to purchase rehabilitation equipment.
