A specialist Information & Advice Officer will be on hand to help with benefit checks, attendance allowance, filling in forms, housing issues, problems with goods and services, aids and adaptations and much more.

Also available will be Age Concern Insurance and Energy Services, providing free noobligation quotations for home and contents, travel, motor and motor breakdown insurance designed specially for the over 50's, gas and electricity with exclusive cold weather payments, funeral plans and aid-call (instant help at the touch of a button).

On alternative months, these services will be joined by PIPP (Promoting Independence Partnership Project), which can put you in contact with many different local services to help maintain your independence at home, or find new opportunities and interests.
