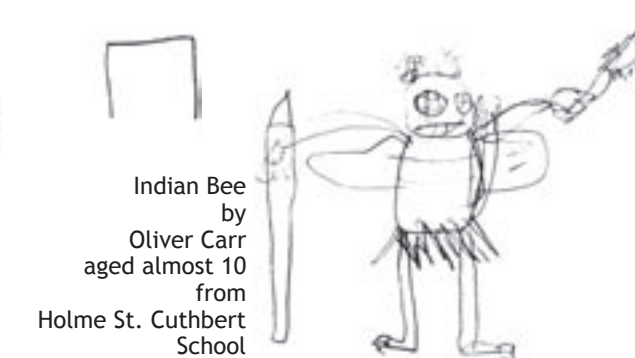

Community Law Centre

Cumbria's National Award Winning Community Law Centre brings legal services direct to your neighbourhood.

This free legal advice service is provided from a customised vehicle, which is wheelchair accessible, has a private interview room and a waiting area. Advice is given by lawyers and prior appointments are not needed. All you need to do is turn up when the van is parked outside the Discovery Centre in Silloth.

Advice can also be given over the telephone and in some circumstances a home visit can be undertaken.

As part of the Community Legal Service Partnership the Law Centre will occasionally allow other partners to use the Mobile Office to deliver advice sessions. The advisor will be clearly advertised on board the



office. The Community Centre Lawyers take on cases and represent clients in

courts and tribunals. The main areas they cover are Housing; Employment; Community Care; Education; Public Law; Mental Health and Welfare Benefits. The Law Centre will not act in all areas of Law. Some of the areas excluded are Criminal Matters; Marriage Problems; Conveyancing; Probate and Neighbour Disputes.

During 2004 10,503 enquiries were answered and the lawyers handled 1,728 cases resulting in cash awards totalling £251,955.

During June the van will be in Silloth from 2pm to 4pm on Wednesday's on the 8th and 22nd.
