Grants for Individual Sports People

Talented sportsmen and women in Allerdale are aiming for the top of their sports thanks to grants given by Allerdale Borough Council.

In its most recent round of Grants to Individual Sports People, the Council supported 17 individuals who participate at regional, national and international level in various sports including motor cross, athletics, tennis, cricket, swimming, American football, golf, cycling and skating.

Amongst the successful applicants for funding were Jamie Law of Cockermouth who received support for safety equipment to compete in the Adult British Motor Cross Championships whilst the grant awarded to Cockermouth's Jon

Fletcher towards entry fees will enable him to participate in an international cycling event.

Assistance with travel expenses and new running spikes helped Workington athlete Steven Fox who won a silver medal in the 800 metres at the Under 17 Amateur Athletics Association Championships and won the North of England Championships and Scottish Championships.

Skating star David King put his grant towards training costs and travel expenses when he represented Great Britain in an international championship in Slovenia last month. Golfer Sebastian Crookhall-Nixon of Cockermouth,

selected for the North of England Junior team, was given support for training expenses.

Clare Moss, Sports Development Officer at Allerdale Borough Council, said: "It is inspiring to see how many high class athletes there are in the borough and we are pleased to be able to support them with their development and sporting successes."

Allerdale is continuing to offer financial assistance to sports people in the borough through its Grants to Individual Sports People Scheme. The Scheme aims to help those who have reached a high standard of performance either at regional level or for those competing in national and international sports events in pursuit of high

sporting achievements in their chosen sport or activity.

Grants can be for:

- * Training costs, inc. travel to and from regional camps or squads and any coaching fees;
- * Purchase of special equipment or specialist clothing or footwear;
- * Entry fees to regional or national competitions and events;
- * Hotel expenses for training sessions or competitions.

Applications are considered on merit on a 'first come - first considered' basis.
