## SILLOTH CARNIVAL NOTICE

Silloth Carnival Committee hope that everyone in Silloth and District will have a very enjoyable Carnival Day.

In view of the large numbers expected to visit Silloth on August 28th the road closures will be much stricter than usual, inevitably this will lead to some inconvenience for local people. A 'Park & Ride' system will be operating with traffic being diverted on to a parking field on the coast road and to Silloth Airfield to park, with buses providing a shuttle service to and from the town. There will be no market on the Airfield in order to accommodate the large numbers of cars expecting to park there. The road around the marsh to Skinburness will also be closed to traffic, this will be used as a clear access route for all emergency vehicles in and out of the town, so badly or inconsiderately parked vehicles will be removed by the Police in the interests of public safety.

The police have asked us to inform local people who have to use their cars to carry some form of identification, or other evidence that they require access to Silloth.

This will be a day in a million for Silloth, the impact of the visit by the Red Arrows, the RAF Falcon Sky Diving Display Team, and a display by a Spitfire, all in addition to the usual Carnival Day activities - cannot be underestimated. Silloth Carnival Committee trusts we will all do our best to show the area off to its best advantage and will take this opportunity to enjoy ourselves.

Silloth Carnival 2006 will be one to remember, please make allowances should there be any inconvenience, after all, it is a day in a million!
