lighthouse and back, the children had great fun and so did everyone else. To date we have collected £200 from our sponsors with

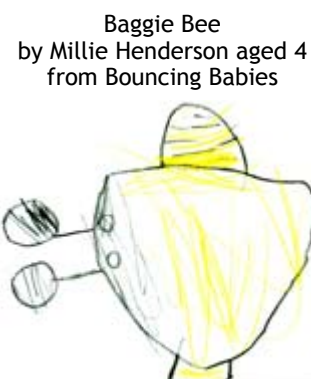
10% going to Silloth Tots N Toddlers and the remaining money collected for Barnados. Thank you to very one who took part.
