## 1942 Lockheed Hudson Crash Site

On the 10th November 1942 a Lockheed Hudson mark AM680 left Silloth Airfield on a routine training flight, with a crew of four.

The aircraft crashed on Beda Head, above Martindale, in the Lake District with the loss of all the crew.
