On Saturday 14th June the West Cumbria branch of CAMRA, the Campaign for Real Ale, presented its Spring 2008 Pub of the Season award to the Lowther Arms at Mawbray.

The pub was closed for 18 months after the death of its last owner in 2005 to Christmas 2006, when it was re-opened by Dawn Lindsay and her mother Mary Ritson, from Maryport. With the help of family and friends the pub, which was falling into dereliction, has been transformed into a bright, homely place. The original flagstones had been revealed for the first time in decades, and a long-forgotten fireplace was re-opened.
