Carbon Footprints

Allerdale Borough Council staff put their best foot forward for the environment. They have been rewarded for taking steps to reduce their carbon footprint and help protect the environment from climate change. The council held a climate change competition to encourage its employees to measure their own carbon footprint and find out who had the lowest emissions in terms of home energy use, household appliance use and travel.

The prizes were presented to staff in Allerdale House by Councillor Margaret Jackson, the council's deputy leader and Executive member with responsibility for climate change, on Thursday 5th June to mark World Environment Day.

Paul Young, from the council's Land Charges and Licensing department was found to have the lowest travel emissions, and won a solar-powered battery charger.

Peter Campbell, of the Customer Service centre, made energy savings through his choice of electrical appliances and was rewarded with a standby saver device which can switch off the power to the items at the mains socket when he uses a remote control.

In addition another eight staff were given prizes.

May was a busy month with nine vessels visiting the port.

The first was the JURMALA with fertilizer from the Black Sea, the tanker ZAPADNY then brought a small cargo of molasses from Dunkirk and the JASON arrived with fertilizer from Sfax in North Africa. The VALIENT then brought fertilizer from Ijmuiden and the ZAPADNY brought a full cargo of molasses from Ghent.

Next were two cargoes of wheat in the BEN VARREY from Sharpness and the CELTICA HAV from Rostock. Finally the SCOTIA came with paper pulp from Northern Spain and the ISLAY TRADER had fertilizer from Ijmuiden.

Councillor Jackson said: "Allerdale Borough Council is in the process developing an action plan to tackle climate change but has already taken a number of steps to reduce energy consumption, reduce waste and recycle more as part of the council's operations and activities. Our staff are a crucial part of reducing the borough's carbon footprint and this competition is part of the steps we are taking to make staff more aware."
