Annual Town Meeting

Report by:

In attendance were
seven council members,
ten members of the public
and apologies from two
council members. The
councillors reports and
year end accounts were
received with apologies
from some councillors for
not having their reports
in on time.

Matters raised ranged
from: Lack of up to date
names on the website,
this has been amended.
The areas covered by the
street sweeper following
last years concerns for
the pensioners area and
West Silloth, this has
been passed to Allerdale
Borough Council with
very little response. The
lack of action regarding
the use of the Youth Club
building, it is still the
same, with a lack of adult
volunteers to supervise.
The Senior School are
bidding for a skills
training centre and may
make use of the building.

Several queries were
raised regarding the
amounts under budget
headings, these mainly
related to the fact the

budgets have to be set by
mid December, when the
end of the financial year
is 31st March. However
several items have the
ability to be adjusted.

It was suggested that
an attendance register of
councillors at meetings be
added to future reports.

An update on the
Heritage Lottery bid
was given by Councillor
Allison, a 58 page, 68
page and 52 page report
with a further two yet to
be received, after which
final amendments will be
made prior to the stage
one bid being submitted.
It is hoped for a reply
around the turn of the
year. A question on the
lack of police cover in
the town yet again was
raised and that no one
was in attendance at this
meeting. The public's
concerns have been
passed to Inspector Allen,
who has only recently
taken over at Wigton.

A vote of thanks was
given to all attendees,
several then took the
opportunity to see the
upgraded Discovery
Centre, it is well worth a
visit.
